BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 14-2022: RE- INSPECTION FEES. If after the initial inspection and one (1) re—inspection, the applicant will be charged a re-inspection fee of \$75.00. This fee shall be charged if the applicant has failed to meet the scheduled re- inspection date, and/or if the violations have not been corrected within 30 days.



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GET A HEAD START ON YOUR "CO" INSPECTION

All inspections are done in accordance with IPMC 2015. The inspector may find some additional items upon inspection.

- 1. Must have a smoke alarm in working order on each level of the home and in every bedroom.
- 2. Install a Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarm within 10 feet of the sleeping areas. The alarm may be hardwired, battery operated or plug in and installed according to the manufactures instructions.
- 3. Fire Extinguisher Compliance The law defines portable fire extinguisher as; an operable portable device, carried and operated by hand, containing an extinguishing agent that can be expelled under pressure for the purpose of suppressing or extinguishing fire and must be:
 - Rated for residential use consisting of an ABC type weighing 2.5 lbs
 - Mounted within 10' of the cooking area.
- 4. A Heater and Roof Certification (Resale Only) must be provided by a NJ. Licensed Contractor. In lieu of certification, private home inspection is acceptable, or if a new roof or new heater has been installed under a UCC permit in the last 5 years, no certs will be required.
- 5. Heater/Chimney connection must be secured properly.
- 6. Hot Water Heater must have drip leg/relief valve a min. of 2 6 inches from the floor.
- 7. Sump pumps cannot discharge in sewer line.
- 8. Sidewalks, walkways and any other concrete work must be in good condition and must have a walkway to house with no tripping hazards.
- 9. Steps 24" above grade needs a graspable handrail w/ returns on one side to hold 100 lbs. Steps 44" & wider need one graspable handrail w/returns on each side.
- 10. Decks, porches, etc. 24" above grade must have a railing with guardrails, 4" maximum, around perimeter.
- 11. Interior steps must have handrail w/returns for all open stairwell edges.
- 12. GFCI outlets must be installed within 6 feet of all sinks & along all kitchen counter tops.
- 13. All outlet/switch plates must be covered.
- 14. NO openings in electrical breaker box allowed.
- 15. Fix any water leaks and make sure that all faucets work properly.
- 16. Fix any holes on the walls, floors, etc.
- 17. Paint any exposed wood, interior and exterior.
- 18. Clean up all trash and debris from property.
- 19. Proper numbers/identification must be on the house visible from the street.

BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 14-2022: Violation Fees. Failure to complete violations within 30 days, may result in a \$25 fine per day for the applicant for each and every day the violation continues. This violation shall be considered a separate and distinct offense.
