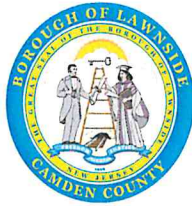

REOSLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LAWNSIDE**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A
RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expend existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2019 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lawnside to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure, the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lawnside, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Borough of Lawnside hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Joseph Ciano to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

TAX IDENTIFICATION STATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Recycling Enhancement Act, P.L. 2007, Chapter 311, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, there is levied upon the owner or operator of every solid waste facility (with certain exceptions) a recycling tax of \$3.00 per ton on all solid waste accepted for disposal or transfer at the solid waste facility; and

WHEREAS, whenever a municipality operates a municipal service system for solid waste collection, or provides for regular solid waste collection service under a contract awarded pursuant to the "Local Public Contracts Law", the amount of grant monies received by the municipality shall not be less than the annual amount of recycling tax paid by the municipality except that all grant monies received by the municipality shall be expended only for its recycling program.

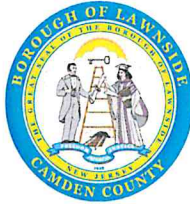
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Lawnside hereby certifies a submission of expenditure for taxes paid pursuant to P.L. 2007, Chapter 311, **in 2019 in the amount of \$1,177.95**. Documentation supporting this submission is available at 4 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Road, Lawnside, NJ, and shall be maintained for not less than five years from this date.

REOSLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LAWNSIDE

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION OF ESTIMATED TAX BILLS
FOR THE YEAR OF 2020**

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services, State of New Jersey has the authority by State Statue to examine, review and then certify all local government budgets to the County Board of Taxation for the purpose of real estate taxation; and

WHEREAS, the Camden County Board of Taxation has not yet received certification of the *Borough of Lawnside, 2020* budget and cannot strike a tax rate until such certification is received from the State of New Jersey and will therefore cause the delay in receiving state funding; and

WHEREAS, in light of the disruption caused by the coronavirus outbreak, the Division of Local Governments Services strongly recommends, in Local Finance Notice 2020-07, that municipalities prepare estimated property tax bills for *2020*; and

WHEREAS, the *Borough Council* has determined that there will be insufficient cash flow to support operations in August *2020* unless third quarter revenue is received on time; and


WHEREAS, the Tax Collector and the Chief Financial Officer have reviewed and computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the *Borough Council* of the *Borough of Lawnside, County of Camden*, State of New Jersey, hereby authorized that:

1. The Tax Collector is directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Municipality of *Borough of Lawnside* for the third quarter *2020*, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2et seq.
2. The entire estimated tax levy for *2020* is hereby set at **\$ 9,241,666.52**
3. The Tax Collector takes any additional steps necessary to immediately implement this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk provides a certified copy of this resolution to the Tax Collector.

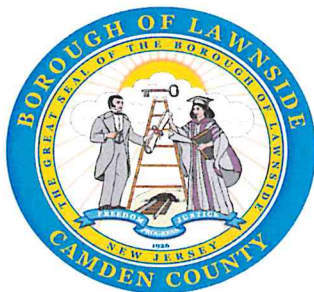

RESOLUTION NO. 52-2020

**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE TAX COLLECTOR
TO EXTEND THE GRACE PERIOD
FOR THE SECOND QUARTER PROPERTY TAXES**

WHEREAS, in light of Coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) on April 28th, 2020, Governor Murphy signed Executive Order No. 130 to allow municipalities to extend the grace period for property tax payments due on May 1st to June 1st; and

WHEREAS, an extension is given to property owners to pay the property taxes a month after they are due without incurring any interest costs or penalties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lawnside, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Tax Collector is directed to extend the grace period for payment of the Second Quarter 2020 Taxes until June 1st, 2020.
