
**AUTHORIZING THE 4TH of JULY COMMITTEE to HOST LAWNSIDE HERITAGE

AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expend existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2022 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lawnside to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and


WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure, the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lawnside, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Borough of Lawnside hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Joseph Ciano to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

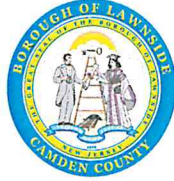

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF VOORHEES FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN AND GRANT
MANAGEMENT SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 ET SEQ. FOR THE
PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS AT ASHLAND
PATCO STATION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Borough of Lawnside is authorized to enter into an agreement for shared services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lawnside ("Lawnside") and Voorhees are desirous of entering into a Shared Services Agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) ("Shared Services Act"), whereby Voorhees' Special Projects Engineer, Environmental Resolutions, Inc. ("ERi") would provide engineering design and grant management services for the pedestrian and bicycle improvements to access the Ashland PATCO Station; and

WHEREAS, under the Shared Services Act, any local unit may enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating local units; and

WHEREAS, a Shared Services Agreement between the Parties has been prepared setting forth the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and


WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement incorporates all of the terms of the agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lawnside finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Borough of Lawnside to enter into the Shared Services Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lawnside as follows:

1. The Mayor and/or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Lawnside for engineering design and grant management services for the pedestrian and bicycle improvements to access the Ashland PATCO Station
2. The Shared Services Agreement shall be placed on file in the office of the Clerk of the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lawnside.
3. The Clerk Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lawnside is hereby authorized and directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution and a copy of the fully executed Agreement to the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs and to the Department of Environmental Protection for informational purposes.

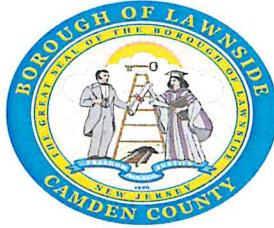


GRANTING VETERAN DEDUCTION FOR CERTAIN PROPERTY



WHEREAS, William Garvin Jr. submitted his application to our Assessor/Collector and has met the eligibility requirements and is granted Veteran Deduction; and

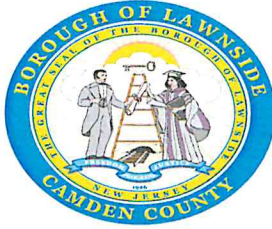

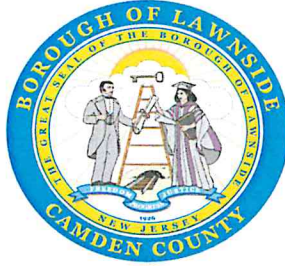


**RESOLUTION GRANTING A TOTALLY DISABLED

TAX EXEMPTION**



RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAWNSIDE
TO APPROVE THE CROSSROADS OF THE REVOLUTION HISTORIC
INTERPRETIVE SIGN LOCATION

WHEREAS, the Camden County Historical Society has received a grant from the National Park Service American Battlefield Protection Program (ABPP), that was matched by the Camden County Historic Preservation Program to create the Camden County American Revolution Trail Signage and Mobile Audio App Project; and

WHEREAS, the Camden County Historical Society, in partnership with the Borough of Lawnside and the Lawnside Historical Society, has identified the Wayne R. Bryant Senior Community Center as an appropriate location to describe the African American experience during the American Revolution (see attached Exhibit for proposed location); and

WHEREAS, the American Battlefield Protection Program has required the Borough of Lawnside to approve the Wayne R. Bryant Senior Community Center location; and


WHEREAS, the Camden County Historical Society requires the assistance of the Lawnside Department of Public Works to transport one concrete slab from the Camden County Parks Department facility to the Wayne R. Bryant Senior Community Center and to assist with sign installation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lawnside agrees to provide regular maintenance of the site location that includes grass cutting, tree pruning, trash removal, etc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Lawnside hereby approves the location of the Wayne R. Bryant Senior Community Center for a Crossroads of the Revolution sign; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough of Lawnside will direct the Lawnside Public Works Department to assist with the final installation in the designated location.
