WHEREAS, Homeowner request refund of monies for that period of time due to the building is not in use; and


WHEREAS, Sewer Department request a refund of \$720.00 for 7 Hodges Avenue Lawnside New Jersey; account 738-0;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, through its Public Safety Committee, have determined that the Police Department is in need of a full-time Police Officer Patrolman I; and
