WHEREAS, sufficient time must be given to property owners to pay the taxes without incurring any interest costs or penalties.

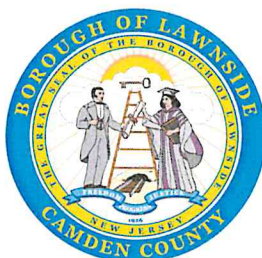

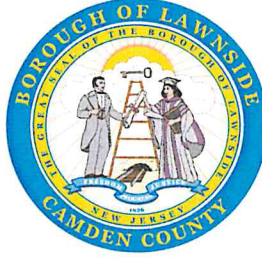
**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH CLERK

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lawnside is in need of the collection, removal and disposal of trash, and garbage, to provide for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the month to month contract will be effective September 1, 2020 until such time that The Borough of Lawnside has been able to receive bids, and execute a new trash collection contract, or December 31, 2020, whichever date is the earliest; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator and Borough Solicitor recommend that Mayor and Council award trash collection for a month to month basis beginning September 1, 2020 and ending when The Borough of Lawnside has been able to receive bids, and execute a new trash collection contract, or December 31, 2020, whichever date is the earliest, to **South Jersey Sanitation, 253 N. White Horse Pike, Hammonton, NJ 08037 at a rate of \$98.71 per ton for weekly trash collection.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lawnside that the Business Administrator and Borough Solicitor take any and all steps necessary to ensure the implementation of this agreement.

WHEREAS, Lawnside Borough supports Voorhees Township submission of an for a federally Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) dollars from the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) for the **Evesham Road Pedestrian and Bike Lane Improvements for Access to Ashland PATCO Station** Project located in the Townships of Cherry Hill & Voorhees and the Boroughs of Somerdale & Lawnside in the County of Camden; and




